## 34. ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNCIL

The Chairman made the following announcements:-

## 1. Outgoing Chairman

The Chairman thanked the outgoing Chairman for all his efforts on behalf of the Council during the previous year.

## 2. Chairman's Charity

The Chairman informed the Council that she had not yet chosen a charity but would be doing so in the near future.

## 3. <u>Civic Service</u>

The Chairman indicated that she would be reviving the Civic Service and arrangements would be announced in due course.

## The Deputy Leader of the Council made the following announcement:-

The Deputy Leader of the Council welcomed all new members to the Council and congratulated them on their election.

The Deputy Leader also made reference to the current bid by Wiltshire County Council to set up a unitary authority for the whole of Wiltshire. He urged members to become involved in the campaign against unitary status and to write in person to the Secretary of State in opposition to the move. Support for the District Council should be canvassed right until the end of the consultation period.

### 39. ELECTION OF DEPUTY LEADER OF THE COUNCIL
