REVIEW OF POLLING DISTRICTS, POLLING PLACES AND POLLING STATIONS

REPORT BY THE CHIEF EXECUTIVE

1. PURPOSE OF REPORT

To advise Members of a statutory review of polling districts, polling places and polling stations and to seek approval for a schedule of polling arrangements to form the starting point of a wider consultation.

2. FINANCIAL, RISK, STAFFING AND LEGAL IMPLICATIONS

Failure to complete a review may leave the Council liable to legal challenge from either individual voters or interested groups, in particular those with disabilities or with an interest in disabled access.

3. INTRODUCTION

The Electoral Administration Act 2006 requires relevant councils to carry out a review of polling districts and places during 2007. Public Notice will be given of the schedule of polling districts and places approved by Council, with Town and Parish Councils, constituency parties, special interest groups and individual electors being given the opportunity to comment on the proposals prior to the next meeting of the Council, when a further report for final approval will be submitted.

4. BACKGROUND

In carrying out the review the Council is required to give consideration to the opinions of the Returning Officer and a body with expertise in relation to access matters. The Council's Building Control section were appointed, through the last round of Service Delivery Plans, as the required inspectors with a particular expertise in relation to access to premises

5. RETURNING OFFICER'S COMMENTS

In general the polling stations currently in use in the District are of a satisfactory standard. I would make the following specific comments:

• Within Marlborough, although the Leisure Centre satisfies all of the criteria for the review, I am aware that residents of East Ward would prefer to see

a separate polling station within the Ward. St Margaret's Mead Youth Centre is suggested as a suitable location.

- I have received a request to use Seend Community Centre in place of the Irene Usher Hall, and agree that it is an acceptable change.
- At the last round of elections, residents of Everleigh requested that their polling place be set in Collingbourne Ducis, rather than Collingbourne Kingston, and there is no reason not to concur.
- The polling stations currently used in both Great Cheverell and Market Lavington do not meet the required access criteria. In both of those parishes new village halls are under construction and will be available for the next round of elections. I propose that the polling place for Little Cheverell be moved to Great Cheverell from West Lavington.
- There are a number of further venues in small parishes that struggle to meet access standards. However, as they are the only available premises in those parishes I propose that they still be used as polling stations. The venues in question are listed within the inspection results.
- The existing polling district arrangements for Roundway are confusing, being based upon a historic provision of a separate polling district for Roundway hospital in the centre of the parish. I propose that the polling districts for Roundway be re-organised into a North/South arrangement, with the A342 forming the boundary between the 2 polling districts.

6. INSPECTION RESULTS

A full schedule of inspection results has been e-mailed to all members and can be supplied in hard copy on request. The schedule highlights premises that already comply (priority 1 within report), those that could be brought up to required access standards with relatively little work (priority 2) and those that fail access standards with little or no prospect of improvement (priority 3).

7. CONCLUSIONS

The accessibility of polling stations within Kennet has improved steadily since 1997, owing to: owners of buildings carrying out works to improve disabled access; a number of new village halls being built over this period and changes of venues made by the Council following its last review in 2002.

The report identifies a number of venues that fall short of either required or desirable access standards. Simple accessibility to premises has to be balanced against travelling distances and convenience for the majority of voters. It is my view that the closure of any of the remaining polling stations would result in overlong journeys for voters, unless either members or the consultation process identify suitable alternatives within those parishes.

8. RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that:

- 1. The schedule of polling places and polling stations at Appendix A be approved for consultation, along with the revision to the polling districts for Roundway.
- 2. the Council's grants officer contact those premises identified as requiring minimal works to meet access standards to assist any that meet the relevant criteria to apply to the Council for grants towards the cost of those works.
