We achieved 16 points out of 18, giving a percentage of 88.9%. We missed out on 1 Pendleton point, which we expect to achieve next year to give us a percentage of 94.4%. We also dropped a point base for not having a project management approach to dealing with Major planning applications, which we expect to rectify soon.
