**If successful, how will you spend your grant (e.g. erect a youth shelter)?**

To buy a larger horse Of 14.2hh – 15.0hh of heavy type for disabled adults or children with Downs Syndrome. (Smaller ponies are not suitable for people with some types of disabilities). The horse needs to be of the appropriate temperament – active but quiet and tolerate sudden movement or screams, which can happen with some disabled riders. Also associated saddle, bridle and rugs.

**What does your project aim to achieve?**

A larger horse will make the disabled group accessible to more riders. (See above). Horseriding gives great pleasure and exercise to all disabled people. Unlike most other sports or physical exercise, riding puts no pressure on the limbs. In fact, it helps to strengthen limbs and improve co-ordination. On horseback the disabled feel equal to able-bodied people.

It will encourage more disabled users to join the group. There are about 4 other riding centres in the area offering riding for the disabled but all are over subscribed. At present about 20 people use the Breach Lane group per week from local care homes and day centres as well as private users.

**What other Agencies/Groups/Organisations are involved in this project?**

Local care homes including Ballards Ash, One Step Ahead, the Middlefield Centre use the centre. Around 9 disabled children and young adults as private individuals. Also the Breach Lane Equine Centre.
