This is a busy junction with no lights. The Parish Council has pushed for lighting but Wiltshire County Council does not have funding. However, it has confirmed that it will maintain the lights once they are installed. (This will be reviewed after 2 years). Many residents of Lyneham and Bradenstoke (up to 5000) use this junction regularly and it is difficult and unsafe for use during the hours of darkness – particularly for the mainly elderly population of Bradenstoke.

The project is very environmentally friendly. We would not be using energy but making our own.

NWDC will not meet future running costs for projects. Please tell us how these will be met in future.

Wiltshire County Council has agreed to fund any maintenance. Running costs to be self-financed through wind and solar power.
