## 3 - Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g. consultation & community involvement

The Great Western Community Forest (GWCF) was approached by North Wiltshire District Council to run a Forest Festival in Wootton Bassett after two North Wilts Councillors attended the sixth Forest Festival in Swindon in 2004. GWCF was recognised for its professional expertise in running environmental forest events within the 168 square miles that it covers, including tree planting, school grounds projects, family fun days, liaison with land owners and farmers to help with land diversification, as well as its flagship event, Forest Festival, which has attracted funding from both private sector sponsorship and various grants over 8 years. Wootton Bassett Town Council are fully in support of this project and have already committed £3k funding to the event. The Chamber of Commerce are supporting the event through local business engagement and recognise how valuable this will be to the local economy. The local radio station – Brunel FM – have committed their airtime to the event. The Friends of Jubilee lake are already working with us to involve local schools, including Wootton Bassett Comprehensive School and Longleaze Primary School. GWCF are part of a broad partnership of environmental organisations who can be drawn on to support this event including Wiltshire Wildlife Trust, Wilts & Berks Canal Trust, the Woodland Trust, British Trust for Conservation Volunteers, Ramblers Association, Purton House Organics, English Nature, Forestry Commission and the Environment Agency.
