Some residents also walk to this site with small quantities of items to dispose of. The recycling facility was created some years ago on a piece of land that had been filled with rubble hence at the time it was not thought a good idea to tarmac it as the large collection lorries would impact on the surface. Now it is thought sufficent time has passed to tarmac the surface (10years plus). A tarmaced surface would make it easier to keep the site clean and tidy and provide a safer and better surface for those using the facility to walk on. Currently there is a step down onto the site from the tarmaced surface that is adjacent to this site a new tarmaced surface would remove this step creating a flush surface.
