

Additional Criteria for the Executive Capital Partnership Funding Scheme

<p>Applications must meet all the criteria shown below:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ⌋ A non-profit making organisation or group ⌋ Clearly shows a need for financial support ⌋ Where the project impacts on a single community area applications must have secured an award of at least £15,000 from the relevant Area Committee along with a request that the Executive considers providing additional funding ⌋ Where projects impact across more than one community area applicants must have sought funding from other sources ⌋ Apply before your scheme or project takes place ⌋ Your application is one-off and to pump-prime a new capital project or scheme ⌋ Make no more than one application per project ⌋ The total funding support from North Wiltshire District Council must not exceed 50% of the total cost of the project (the sum of Area and Executive awards) ⌋ Your project or scheme will benefit the community ⌋ You have considered and planned for the future sustainability of your project including on-going revenue funding (no application for revenue funding will be considered by the Executive) ⌋ If you project requires planning permission, building regulations or any other form of licence or approval, this must be granted <u>prior</u> to submitting your application for a grant ⌋ Applications from charitable organisations, should submit a copy of their signed off accounts. If these are not provided this will void your application. ⌋ Town and Parish Councils will not receive any more funding than that contributed by the Town or Parish Council 	<p>The Council will not consider applications from the following applicants, unless your project can demonstrate a wider community benefit.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ÿ Political or Religious groups (other than where there are wider community benefits) Ÿ Statutory bodies to help fund their core services Ÿ Individuals for their sole benefit Ÿ Any organisation making an application for grant which could reasonably be expected to finance the project or scheme by other means Ÿ A profit making organisation Ÿ Festivals
