## Agents Fee Structure

The purpose of an agent is to assist people to submit applications for assistance and to monitor the required works through to completion.

It was agreed by the Environment Housing and Health Sub-Committee on  $31^{\rm st}$  July 1997 that the maximum fees that could be charged by an agent was 12% of £5000 and 10% thereafter of the cost of eligible works.

The fees below have been discussed with and have been agreed as workable by North Wilts Care & Repair (the local Home improvement agency)
