Terms of Reference – Area Committees

- 1. to discharge the functions and responsibilities of the authority within the Area subject to budgetary provision and subject to the following exceptions:
 - a) Matters which involve new policy or the substantial variation or extension of a new policy
 - b) Allocation and control of the financial, establishment and property resources of the Council including the approval of and any amendment to the revenue budget and the capital programme.
 - c) Matters which have an impact on more than one Area
 - d) Matters within the terms of reference of other committees
 - e) Acquisition and disposal of interests in land and other dealings in land having a value of over £30,000.
- 2. to consider and determine in relation to the Area any matter referred to the Area Committee for determination.
- 3. to undertake public consultation on issues affecting the Area.
- 4. to make recommendations to the Executive and Council with regard to the provision of facilities and services within the Area.
- 5. to monitor the provision of services and facilities within the Area.
- 6. to appoint to outside bodies which operate exclusively or primarily within the Area.
- to consider reports from members on outside bodies and determine matters arising from a report which does not involve a change of policy and for which budgetary provision can be found.
- 8. to disseminate information relating to services and facilities within the Area.
- 9. to consider and make recommendations on Development Plans and Plans comprising the Local Development Framework relating to the Area.
- 10. to arrange presentations by outside agencies on service provision within the Area.
- 11. to make representations to outside agencies relating to service provision within the Area.
- 12. to be responsible for the allocation of all area based grants
