APRIL Round Up

PRESENTATION – NEW VISION FOR PETERSFIELD'S FUTURE.

Mr Tony Struthers, Chairman of Petersfield Tomorrow Committee gave a presentation on the future plans for Petersfield and an update on the work done so far.

The Economic Development Officer East Hants District Council gave a short presentation on "The Opportunity for Tourism" and the Economic Development & Tourism Manager spoke about the current and future outlook for the Petersfield in respect of job opportunities for the young, quality of life and opportunities.

Councillors and members of the public asked a number of questions and expressed a number of concerns in particular about the suggested pedestrianisation of the High Street in Petersfield and its effects on trade in the area.
