In other Area News......

North Wiltshire District Council is one of nine organisations that are celebrating after hearing the news from The Big Lottery that the Cricklade Country Way project has progressed to the final stage of the Living Landmarks bidding process.

A grant of £250k has been made available so that the team can continue to work on the £15m scheme. When completed a business plan will be submitted in May 2007 for a £12.8m grant.

NWDC is the lead partner for the project and Chaloner Chute, Canal Project Director says, "All the partners are really excited that the work of the last eight years in preparing for the Cricklade Country Way is now taking a step nearer reality. This scheme represents a unique mix of Local Authorities, national organisations and voluntary Trusts working together. The cooperation and dedication of the project team and their own organisations, deserves much praise. We look forward to challenge of the next few months to progress towards the winning tape".
