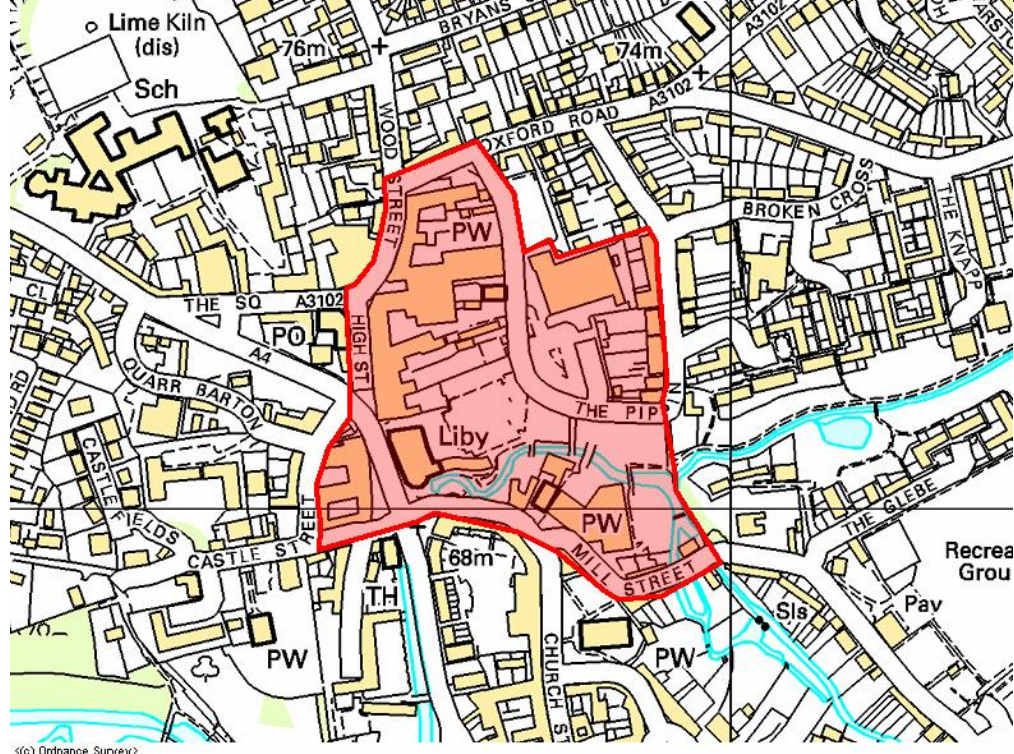




**ANTI-SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR ACT 2003
NOTICE OF AUTHORISATION OF POLICE POWERS**

Land contained in and around Calne

Notice is hereby given that as Superintendent of Police for the Wiltshire BCU including Calne area of the Wiltshire Police, having consulted with the Chief Executives of North Wiltshire District and Wiltshire County Councils, I have given authorisation for Constables or Police Community Support Officers in uniform to exercise powers which are set out in Section 30(3) to (5) of the Anti Social Behaviour Act 2003 in the following locality, namely: **Wood Street, junction Oxford Road, Oxford Road junction with Pinnin Mill Street, junction Castle Street and all land contained therein. As**



For the following period, namely: **Six Months from Monday 2nd April 2007.**

This means that, in the locality specified above and during the period stated, a Constable or Police Community Support Officer in uniform can give directions where there are reasonable grounds for believing that the presence or behaviour of a group of two or more persons in any public place has resulted or is likely to result in any member of the public being intimidated, harassed, alarmed or distressed. Persons in the group can be directed to disperse and/or leave the locality. It is an offence to fail to comply with a Constable's or Police Community Support Officer's direction, and the offender can be arrested for such an offence without a warrant.
