1 member of the Development Control Committee

5 Stakeholders invited by the Authorised Officer (provided they undertake to observe the Council's Code of Conduct)

Political proportionality: Advisory Bodies do not have to be politically proportional.

Meetings: As required. (Expect 4 per year)

Open to the press and Public: Meetings will be held in private unless the public are

specifically invited to attend (access to information rules do not apply). Agendas & Minutes will remain confidential unless the Chairman of the Advisory Body decides otherwise. Agendas & Minutes are available to all

Councillors, but are not public documents.

Quorum There is no quorum for an Advisory Body.

Decision Making No – the Advisory Group will where appropriate make

recommendations on Spatial Planning Matters to the Authorised Officer (currently the Head of Policy &

Performance).

Terms of Reference

The Spatial Planning Working Group shall receive updates on Spatial Planning matters and when appropriate will advise the Authorised Officer (currently the Head of Policy & Performance) ahead of the Officer exercising delegated authority on matters including:

- 1. The production of the North Wiltshire Local Development Framework.
- 2. The Regional Spatial Strategy.
- 3. All spatial planning matters in accordance with the amended Scheme of Delegation approved by the Executive on 11th May 2006.
