Malmesbury Youth FC currently has 210 registered players, both boys and girls aged between the ages of 6 and 16 and is one of 6 clubs in the county to be recognised by the Football Association as a Charter standard Development Club which demonstrates best practise in coaching, administration and Child Protection. The club is a focal point for young people in Area 1 drawing in players from Malmesbury as well as throughout the villages of Hankerton, Crudwell, Lea and Brokenborough and beyond. The club is currently expanding to cater for women and girls football with a view to encouraging the development of various age groups sides to compete in local competitions for girls. The boys football is also continuing to grow with the community attitude of the club attracting parents and their children. As a result of this success in attracting young people into sport and retaining them, the club has totally outgrown its changing facilities which is currently an old mobile trailer. This is not an appropriate changing facility for young people and it will considerably hinder the development of girls football alongside the current provision. The proposed Clubhouse/Changing Facility will fulfil a Community need for a modern facility that will become the heart and focal point of the Football Club, thereby encouraging the youth of Malmesbury and surrounding areas to participate in organised sport. It will enable girls and boys football to occur alongside each other and will include a First Aid room for emergency use. This will enable the club to deliver sport in a safe, well structured and appropriate manner and continue to offer activities that will indirectly assist with community safety issues such as anti social benhaviour. The development will also achieve one of the key points of the Community Plan which is to develop a strong sense of community as well as providing a leisure facility that will enable more young people to become involved in a physically active lifestyle. A management sub-committee, reporting to the Club Committee, will be established within the Club to oversee the management of the Clubhouse. The semi-permanent building will be located on land for which we have a long-term lease agreement.
