1. Introduction

- 1.1 The 25th January 2006 Area 1 Committee resolved that;
 - (1) That the Malmesbury Conservation Area Statement 'Consultation Draft January 2006' be approved for the purposes of consultation in accordance with Section 71 of the Planning (Listed Buildings and Conservation Areas) Act 1990.
 - (2) That consideration be given to the production of an executive summary;
 - (3) That a letter be sent by the Chairman to all the volunteers who worked hard to produce the Statement;
 - (4) That the consultation result be reported back to the Area Committee prior to the consideration of the Statement by the Public Spaces & Local Plans Panel and the Executive

Details of the processes of production and intended programme of consultation for that document are contained in <u>Report No.9</u> to that Committee.

- 1.2 Extended new guidance on *Conservation Area Appraisals* and *Management of Conservation Areas* were published by English Heritage in February 2006. These recommended that Conservation Area Appraisals be produced and published as separate documentary evidence to Conservation Area Management Plans, which would then be adopted as Supplementary Planning Documents (SPDs) after public consultation in accordance with the local authority's Statement of Community Involvement.
- 1.3 This separation of the previous contents of Conservation Area Statements has advantages in that the extended appraisal and analysis of a Conservation Area is published ahead of, and separately to, a more concise Management Plan document which principally contains the actual proposals for preservation and enhancement within the Conservation Area.
- 1.4 After February 2006 the suite of conservation related documents to be produced as part of the Local Development Scheme (LDS) was amended to take account of the new English Heritage guidance. It is now programmed that an overall North Wiltshire Conservation Area Character and Criteria document will be produced and adopted as an SPD, in addition to Conservation Area Management Plans for each of the six main town conservation areas. A programme of Conservation Area Appraisals for each of the district's conservation areas has also been commenced, although these do not require to be adopted as SPDs under the new guidance.
- 1.5 The <u>Malmesbury Conservation Area Appraisal April 2007</u> is available on the North Wiltshire District Council website. The analysis contained in this document has been used to inform the Malmesbury Conservation Area Management Plan Consultation Draft November 2007, a black and white copy of which is attached as Appendix 1. A full colour version can also be accessed on the North Wiltshire District Council website under <u>'Committee Agendas and Minutes</u>'.
- 1.6 It is intended that (subject to approval by this Committee) the Malmesbury Conservation Area Management Plan - together with a Consultation Draft of the overall North Wiltshire Conservation Area Character and Criteria document – will be considered by a forthcoming meeting of the Spatial Planning Advisory Group (SPAG) prior to commencement of the public consultation process in accordance with the Statement of Community Involvement (SCI). The overall Conservation Area Character and Criteria document cross-references to the Local Plan (and other guidance/policies) a longer list of Development Guidelines and Enhancement Proposals (proposals for preservation and enhancement) contained in the various Management Plans, and identifies the parties involved in implementation of each.

2. Options and Options Appraisal

- 2.1 The Planning Authority has a duty to prepare proposals for preservation and enhancement for its designated Conservation Areas and BVPI 219 requires the production of Management Plans to discharge this duty. The Malmesbury Conservation Area Management Plan is also agreed for production in the North Wiltshire Local Development Scheme (LDS) programme. Not progressing or adopting a Management Plan reduces performance against this duty, indicator and programme.
- 2.2 A voluntary Working Group (comprising members of the existing Malmesbury Conservation Area Liaison Group) was first set up in 2002 to progress research and analysis. The Development Guidelines and Enhancement Proposals have been considered and agreed with that group. Any proposed alteration of proposals in the Management Plan can be considered in the consultation process.

4. Financial Implications

- 4.1 The Conservation Area Management Plan identifies and prioritises a number of enhancements. It is intended that some of these may form the basis for allocation of available enhancement funding and for future bids to the Area Committee and/or other bodies for partnership funding.
- 4.2 Graphic design for the final printed adopted Management Plan and associated leaflet will be prepared in-house. The proposed design and format will be able to be viewed as part of the exhibition. Printing of the statement is expected to be done in-house with existing printing facilities from team revenue printing budgets.

5. Community and Environmental Implications

5.1 Conservation Area Management Plans contain proposals to conserve and enhance the District's built environment and landscape setting, to protect and promote the local distinctiveness of North Wiltshire's heritage for the community.

6. Risk Analysis

- 6.1 Supplementary Planning Documents are intended to amplify and clarify Local Plan policies in specific locations or in relation to a specific subject. Application of Development Guidelines contained in the adopted Management Plan should therefore be at less risk of being contested than ad-hoc interpretation of generic Local Plan conservation policies in relation to individual planning applications.
- 6.2 There are generic safety and financial risks associated with the carrying out of Enhancement Proposal works, particularly within the public highway, and these are mitigated through the application of Council standing orders and financial regulations in placing the relevant order for works.
