North Wiltshire District Council / Wiltshire County Council Actions

Goosey Corner

- 1. Gain clearance of the watercourse on the east side of the A429 –. North Wiltshire District Council's Engineer will contact the owner following the normal enquiries.
- 2. Wiltshire County Council's Highway Project Manager to organise a survey of the drainage system from Rommel Lane to beyond the A429 so that appropriate measures can be taken to improve the system.
 - **a.** North Wiltshire District Council's Engineer to contact the Environment Agency in order to ascertain the status of the 'piped watercourse' i.e. whether the necessary approvals/consents have been gained.
- 3. Wiltshire County Council's Highway Project Manager to contact the owner of York House regarding the drainage through his land.

The Butts

- 1. The owner of the watercourse on the east of the A429 to be contacted by North Wiltshire District Council's Engineer with a view to gaining clearance.
- 2. Wiltshire County Council's Highway Project Manager to ensure that all highway coverts are clear.

Swill Brook

- Crudwell Parish Council is the riparian owner up to the A429 bridge. Beyond the
 bridge the brook falls within the purview of the Environment Agency. North
 Wiltshire District Council's Engineer to write to the Environment Agency with a
 view to extending the main river section back to where the new Wiltshire County
 Council bridge crosses Tuners Lane and with a view to gaining clearance of the
 brook beyond the A429 bridge.
- 2. Wiltshire County Council has offered to extend the pipe (on Parish Council land) from the edge of the road into the Swill Brook.
