What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?	
<p>The community benefit of the provision of the accoustic ceiling tiles at Brinkworth Village Hall is that it will reduce ambient noise levels in the Village Hall, aid and improve communication between users. Since the Hall was extended and renovated earlier in 2007, it has been found that the change in shape of the hall has resulted in an increase in ambient noise and resonance which is proving very difficult for elderly users, who have impaired hearing, to hear each other. This same problem is causing difficulties for the drama and music groups due to an increased echo. This difficulty is manifesting in a different way with children and youth groups including playgroup, toddlers and Beavers, in that the overall noise level is higher, making it very difficult for adult workers to be heard. Without this improvement the use of this vital Village hub could be affected. The provision of a new stage system would enable all users to be able to use staging more easily, and more safely. It would be of particular use to the drama groups, music groups, and youth groups. It would also be used for the village wide quizzes which are extremely popular, taking place approximately bimonthly. The stacking stage system will facilitate more storage space for other hall users, it can also be ramped to enabled disabled stage users. This project will benefit up to approximately 120 people at any one time and the total number of individual users during the year will be into the thousands</p>

<p>Brinkworth Village Hall is the central community focus in our linear village and is used by many different groups and individuals including: Youth Drama Group, Playgroup, Mothers and Toddlers, Brownies, Beavers, Dance Group, Pilatus Group, Yoga Group, Ladies Club, Gardening Club, Church Youth Groups, Bramble Patchers sewing group, Retired People's Tea Club, local youth bands and music group for practise and performance, dog training classes and Parish Council meetings. There are regular quiz nights that are held as a social gathering, and are always full to capacity, they also raise funds to sustain groups in the village. Individual bookings for special occasions and parties continue. All village users support this necessary project and have expressed difficulties with the accoustics in the hall. A full village consulation and recreational needs analysis was carried out in 2000. We have raised 50% of the cost of these improvements to the village hall and would ask the support from NWDC Area 1 Committee</p>
