<b>What is the Community benefit of your project, and approximately how many people will benefit?</b>			
<p>We have obtained instruments and an excellent sound system for use by young people who have been taking part in music workshops over the last 19 months. They have been getting more confidence in working out and performing their own music. However the sound system does not allow them to hear what sounds they are making when performing. This could be overcome by the use of Foldback Monitors which would enable them not only to hear what they are producing but to balance voice and instrument to produce a well balanced performance. Young People who would not have joined in the music project for the music, are taking an interest in the technology. They are learning how to use the equipment and are being encouraged to share their acquired skills with others. Our equipment can be shared with other village groups and we will encourage young people to work the equipment on behalf of other groups within the community.</p>

170 young people from Oaksey and the local community have been involved in workshop sessions over the past 19 months. This includes children with special needs – Autistic, Aspergers Syndrome and Learning Difficulties, all of whom have benefited greatly from their involvement. Our work is giving young people new experiences of music making, and gives them opportunities to mix with people from other villages and schools because of their common interest. We have seen improvements in teamwork, confidence, ability and many repeat visits to our workshops. In particular we had to hold our hands between the Aspergers lad and his drums last Christmas. At our last concert he was alone on stage quietly accompanying a singer.
