Four members of Siyaya will stay in the area, being hosted free by local families and spend half a day in each school. During that time, the performers will give a music and dance presentation to all of the children and also work with a smaller group who have been selected to join a school choir. Joint rehearsals of all of these children are planned to be held weekly at Malmesbury Primary School who will learn a selection of Siyaya's songs. On 21 st July, all of the school choirs will join the whole of Siyaya (15 performers) to sing in Malmesbury Abbey and then go on to perform with Siyaya at the WOMAD festival at Charlton Park on 24 th July. The community will benefit from the young people and their teachers having an increased awareness of other cultures, very different from their own. Members of the community will also be able to see the performances in the Abbey (an activity welcomed by the vicar – Rev Neill Archer) and the talents of our local school children and their teachers shown to a wider audience at WOMAD. Approximately 2000 children will benefit from this project.
