M&VCAP will be holding a Community Day on April 25th from 11am till 4pm, the purpose of this event is to:

- a) Engage the community in the work of M&VCAP and to encourage more involvement in M&VCAP's future work and community projects;
- b) Share with the community the issues that are coming out of the consultation, for the new Community Area Plan;
- c) Further consult with the community to prioritise the issues raised through our recent consultation so that our work can be of the greatest benefit; and
- d) Engage more with community groups.

M&VCAP have been successful in their bid to Westlea Housing's Community Improvement Fund for £750.00 to host this community event. We are very appreciative of the support received from Westlea and the Residents' District Forum for this generous donation.

Money has been set aside to look at developing transport links with the villages to enable young people living there to access activities within Malmesbury Town.

M&VCAP are holding an informal evening on March 17th, where a presentation about the role and purpose of the partnership will be given to new and prospective members, to further encourage involvement and to give clarity to M&VCAP's role.

The Partnership would welcome everyone interested in making a difference within the community to attend their meetings.
