Latest performance (see analysis overleaf):			
<p>Street Cleanliness (litter and detritus) (BV199a) has shown an improvement on previous year, but current figures suggest we are still in bottom quartile. If we show similar performance in final survey, we should meet our target of 20%. Similar improvement in 2007/08 is required to reach LPSA2 target of 17.5%. Recent trends suggest that we will need to achieve less than 16.5% to move out of the bottom quartile, and we are projected to reach around 19% for this year.</p>			
Reason(s) for current performance:			
<p>We are confident that our inspection methods meet the approved standard. Inspection staff have attended inspection training run by ENCAMS the body that oversees this BVPI. Further training will take place for new staff.</p>			
Forecast performance (What level? By when? National comparison?):			
<p>It is forecast that we will meet the LPSA2 target of 17.5% by 2007/08. There is a current review of the street cleansing service being undertaken which will give improvements in the service delivery.</p>
