OVERVIEW AND SCRUTINY COMMITTEE TERMS OF REFERENCE

- 1. To review or scrutinise decisions made or other action taken in connection with the discharge of any functions which are the responsibility of the Executive.
- 2. To make reports or recommendations to the authority or the Executive with regard to the discharge of any functions which are the responsibility of the Executive.
- 3. To review or scrutinise decisions made or other action taken in connection with the discharge of any functions which are not the responsibility of the Executive.
- 4. To make reports or recommendations to the authority or the Executive with regard to the discharge of any functions which are not the responsibility of the Executive.
- 5. To make reports or recommendations to the authority or the Executive on matters which affect the authority's area or the inhabitants of that area.
- 6. To appoint one or more Sub-Committees to discharge any of its functions.
- 7. To appoint one or more Advisory Bodies to advise on the discharge of any of its functions.
- 8. To require Members of the Executive and senior officers of the authority to attend before it to answer questions.
- 9. To invite any other person to attend meetings of the Committee.
- 10. To exercise the right to "call-in" any decisions made but not yet implemented by the Executive and any other body or person exercising delegated powers on behalf of the authority.
- 11. To consider any decisions "called-in" pursuant to 10 above.
- 12. To consider Best Value Reviews and make recommendations to the Executive.
- 13. To monitor that effective performance and financial management arrangements are in place and to make recommendations to the Executive accordingly.
- 14. To maintain a database to monitor and review its programme of work.
- 15. To undertake those matters identified in Article 6.03 (a) and (b).
- 16. To exercise overall responsibility for the finances allocated to the Committee.
- 17. If applicable to exercise overall responsibility for the work programmes of officers employed to support the work of the Committee.

- 18. To report annually to full Council on work undertaken during the municipal year and the Committee's proposals for a work programme in the ensuing municipal year.
- 19. To appoint to outside bodies that have a scrutiny function.
