E86. Land at Bristol Road, Chippenham – Recommendations of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee

Consideration was given to Report No. 16 (circulated with the Agenda) which presented the recommendations of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee relating to Executive decision E59, which was called in by the Overview & Scrutiny Committee.

Issues discussed during consideration of this item included:

- The views of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee and their wish for Chippenham Town Football Club to be named as the group wishing to purchase the lease of the land at Bristol Road, Chippenham.

Resolved that:

- (1) The map referred to by the Overview and Scrutiny Committee at Appendix 1 to the report be noted.
- (2) The original delegation to the Legal Services Manager be rescinded and that the transaction proceed by way of an option to grant a lease to the Chippenham Town Football Club at market value subject to planning permission being obtained and finance being secured.
- (3) Both the local Ward Members be kept informed of developments and that in future, local Ward Members be kept informed of asset management issues which require Executive decisions and which affect their Ward.
