It is proposed that a new publication, the Community News, will provide a way of communicating news and plans for activities in the Parish, updates from the school, parish council and other community groups Because the school and other active parish groups, societies and clubs will be involved in the content, production and distribution of the Community News, it will help to achieve all three parts of the Resilient Communities objective. In addition, future editions will enable local businesses to advertise, providing them with a way of reaching potential customers and thus helping them weather the recession and support the Action for Wiltshire initiative. All voluntary groups in the parish will be encouraged to advertise events, meetings and the need for volunteers in the publication. The whole of the parish will benefit (approximately 400 households).
