48. Announcements from the Chairman

Member Training

The Chairman drew members' attention to training events that had been organised in the next few weeks commencing with Licensing Training on 22 May from 10.00am to 4.30pm and a Local Government Reorganisation update on 23 May at 7.30pm to which all Members' were encouraged to attend.

The Chairman announced that she was pleased to announce a major step forward with the Council's housing private finance initiative (the PFI scheme).

She said that this was an ambitious project to provide at least 400 much-needed affordable homes throughout West Wiltshire, and that the Council was already delivering through Housing Corporation grants and the planning system.

In the last few days, the government has approved our shortlist of bidders and given the green light to proceed with the next stage in choosing a partner.

After an intensive pre-qualification process, the PFI Project Board decided to shortlist two housing association-led consortia to develop and price their detailed proposals.

One bidder is made up of Sarsen Housing Association and Somer Community Housing Trust; the other includes West Wiltshire Housing Society and Jephson Homes Housing Association.

All four associations are current development partners of the Council and they have an excellent track record of providing affordable homes locally.

Through competition between these two bidders, there was a real opportunity to provide high quality homes and services for many local people in housing need, as well as offering good value for Council Taxpayers.

The PFI scheme has enjoyed a high level of cross-party support to date and she very much hoped that this would continue with the new Council.

49. Election Results

Council received the results of the District Council elections held on 3 May. The Chairman congratulated all those elected and paid tribute to past Councillors who had not stood for re-election or who were not successful in being re-elected.

She also thanked the staff and all those who assisted on the election for the excellent way the election was handled.
