ICT Technical Support for Councillors

It has been determined that the existing internal ICT Technical Support Team are unable to provide the necessary level of technical support to enable Councillors to continue to use their SDC supplied home PC's with the minimum of inconvenience. There are a number of requests for assistance from Councillors still outstanding at the present time, and at least 6 Councillors machines have now failed, with the result that they are currently unable to use email, word processing facilities, etc.

This situation has arisen due to unexpectedly heavy demand for assistance from Councillors, which it was hoped could have been accommodated within the existing resources of the ICT Technical Support Team.

To rectify this situation as swiftly as possible, it is recommended that relevant standing orders be waived, allowing the Head of ICT Services to immediately engage additional <u>technical</u> support only, on a temporary call-off basis, as may be determined dependant on need. In accordance with Cabinet's decision in July 2006, the situation regarding Councillors ICT support and training will be regularised from May 2007, at which time it is intended that a formal contractual arrangement will commence, with a review being taken after a further 6 months.

It is considered that the cost of additional technical support up until May 2007, can be met from within existing ICT budgets.
