The project will benefit approx 120 youngsters, both boys & girls, currently in the club, aged 11-15. It will also enable people of less than adult average height with disabilities, & those with visual or hearing impairments (of which the club has 1 junior member) to be able to learn & practise batting skills, using a modified bowling machine, controlled remotely by the coach, who can stand near to them & make adjustments to their technique as required. It can also be used to enable a disabled person to bat, where bowling was either impractical or a bowler was unavailable. Benefits will be immediate & on-going for youngsters joining in future years, ensuring Biddestone Cricket club remains an attractive choice for youngsters to be taught the game. Cricket represents a positive activity for young people & good coaching with proper supporting equipment reinforces that activity, allowing youngsters to flourish in a supportive & safe environment. This increases their confidence & self esteem as they will improve at a faster rate than would be the case without this equipment. Improved self esteem through sport is widely acknowledged & in turn this benefits the wider community. This will provide a facility that most other clubs do not have, so being able to provide specialist coaching equipment across all age groups & disabilities would support Biddestone's inclusive policy & provide a wider community benefit.

We are a community orientated village club with 6 adult teams and 8 junior teams dedicated to enabling young persons of all abilities to receive coaching to a high standard. In the last several years we have been attracting an increasing number of young persons due in part to our all inclusive structure and quality of coaching. The quality of our structure is recognized by our Club Mark award from the English Cricket Board. The club runs both junior A and B teams in age categories Under 11, 13 and 15, enabling those of all abilities and skills to compete against other clubs. In addition we have an Under 9 age group and a girls team that was started this year. The matches promote confidence, discipline and the importance of team work whilst the high standard of coaching promotes the benefits of ongoing training and practise. This award would benefit almost all young persons in the club and would mean that we could continue to be recognised as an all inclusive club which could offer the use of equipment not widely available elsewhere. We are proud of our all inclusive policy and would wish to enhance it further with this project. I have no doubt whatsoever that the benefit to young persons in the club and those who have yet to join in future years will be substantial. We will know that it is making a difference when those who are being coached tell us how much they enjoy using it, how it helps and when the coaches can see a marked difference in players ability and confidence.
