We believe it is important to provide sports facilities for all members of the community and to encourage the younger members of the community to take part in sport which they may not be able to access at other times. There is a well publicised lack of sports facilities in our area, and we are striving to provide the safest, highest standard facilities possible in order to continue to develop the opportunities we offer to the community. Young people in the local area have limited access to sports facilities, particularly as we are located in a rural area. The Club runs youth coaching sessions on Saturdays during the summer and encourages the younger members of the community to join the Club. They are included in the teams for both friendly and league matches, and most of the youth players continue to play for the Club into adult membership, a situation we wish to maintain. We can only continue this development of the Club if we can provide the best and safest possible playing surface which will enable us to attract fixtures from other clubs in the area. Fixtures against other clubs will not be forthcoming if the facilities are allowed to deteriorate - the purchase of a new mower will enable us to maintain and improve the standard we are able to achieve. Membership is open to everyone, and therefore all members of the community will benefit.

The Cricket Club plays an important part in the life of the community in and around Christian Malford; its members take an active role in local fundraising and are very supportive of the need for continued development of leisure facilities. We encourage all members of the community to be involved in the club, either as players or spectators, and the club benefits from great support from the village. All residents of the village are very pro-active in their desire to improve the facilities and the club is aware of the benefits to the local as well as the wider community of improving the facilities it uses. The village has improved its facilities in recent years by the provision of a new pavilion, and it is important that the Cricket Club takes responsibility for the continuing upkeep of the playing surface to encourage and attract new members which will allow the Club to develop and evolve. The Village Plan supports the continued development of sports facilities in the village. It is important that all members of the community have access to appropriate leisure and sporting facilities within their community. The mower we are planning to purchase will be used to cut both the square and the strip, which is a more energy efficient method than using the two older, inefficient mowers which we have used up to now. These two mowers have become too costly to maintain and we do not anticipate them being in a working condition next season.
