recreational facilities

Report Summary:

The purpose of the report is to seek Committee approval to release developers' contributions associated with new residential development in Salisbury and collected under the terms of policy R2 of the adopted Salisbury District Plan.

1 Portway and Hudson's field pavilions:

Committee will recall the following projects came to this committee for approval of the release of R2 funds. Work has been completed on these projects, and have unfortunately cost more than was originally anticipated.

The reasons for the difference in costs highlighted above are as follows:

- Hudson's Field Pavilion Additional works to upgrade both the electricity and gas supplies from Castle Rd were identified as well as higher than expected quotation costs for the removal and re-instatement of the old oil tank systems (the pavilion is now mains supplied). This additional work also led to an increase in the fees payable to our engineering consultant.
- Portway Pavilion A number of flooring joists were found to be far more rotten than anticipated. These could only be identified once a fair degree of cladding timbers etc had been removed. An amount of foul sewer run was also renewed along with the associated chamber.

In order that this situation does not happen in the future it is proposed that as soon as a potential overspend is highlighted on any R2 project, that a report be brought back to the relevant committee to authorise the release of the additional money at that point.









R2 Funds Available:

Financial contributions have been received from a number of separate residential developments in the City. There is approximately £133,444 of youth adult money plus accrued interest available for expenditure on appropriate off-site recreation facilities because the relevant developments have started.

The total cost of the additional monies required on both projects is £31,126.86. It is requested that Members release available R2 monies for the scheme.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that £31,126.86 of the 'R2' contributions be released by this Council to assist the funding of the recreation schemes outlined above, and that the release of the monies be made following receipt of invoices for the works undertaken.

2 Salisbury athletics track lighting:

On 24th May 2005 City Area Community approved the lighting project as detailed in minute 163. The purpose of this report is to seek committee approval for the release of funds for this project. It was estimated that the project would cost £37,000, but tendered quotations have reduced this amount to £29,000.

R2 Funds Available:

Financial contributions have been received from a number of separate residential developments in the City. There is approximately £102,317.61 of youth adult money plus accrued interest available for expenditure on appropriate off-site recreation facilities because the relevant developments have started.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that £29,000 of the 'R2' contributions be released by this Council to assist the funding of the recreation schemes outlined above, and that the release of the monies be made following receipt of invoices for the works undertaken.
