Proposed Disposal of part of the site of Salisbury Highbury Primary School

Notice of Proposal – Disposal of part of the site of Salisbury Highbury Primary School

Notice is hereby given of the intention of Wiltshire County Council to dispose of a part of the current grass playing area of the school. Application for Secretary of State's consent under Section 77 of the School Standards and Framework Act 1998 will be made in due course.

The County Council is required to consult further on its proposal to dispose of that part of the site which had been used by the school as a grass playing area, occupying approximately 1174 m² of the area at the bottom of the current site. It is proposed that the proceeds of sale will be used towards the costs of providing a replacement school on the site.

The County Council is therefore seeking the views of any and all interested parties on the proposed disposal of part of the grass pitch area on the Salisbury Highbury Primary School site. If you would like to make any comment on the proposal, then please put your views in writing to the address shown at the bottom of this notice, to be received at County Hall no later than 1 December 2006.
