Comments and Interventions

There has been a reduction in the number of calls attended by Corsham Fire Station over the previous two months compared with the same period last year.

Wiltshire Fire and Rescue will be carrying out its “Safe Drive Stay Alive” Road Safety Programme to all Year 11 pupils over the next two months. The Corsham School are due to attend the event in November.

Community Fire Safety Activities have focused on Chimney Fire Safety following an increase in calls to chimney fires last winter. People with open fires, wood stoves and flame effect gas fires are encouraged to get their chimneys swept and flues checked regularly.
