The station began broadcasting 36 years ago to the community hospitals in Devizes. As the hospitals began to be closed the management committee recognised that it needed to look for a wider audience, this it did by providing broadcast services to residential homes for older people in the area. With the impending closure of the community hospital we have been fortunate to increase our audience by adding further residential homes and now broadcast to seven homes and are in discussion with a further 4 about broadcasting to them. The national body for hospital broadcasting (HBO Hospital Broadcasting Organisation) has described what we are doing as innovative and has signposted other stations to us for help. The station broadcasts mainly during the evenings and weekends providing a wide variety of music, speech and local news using the talking book of the Gazette and Herald which we help to produce. Live events such as the Remembrance Day service, the Mayor's carol concert, concerts from the Town Hall and Corn Exchange are broadcast live or recorded and broadcast later. Our main beneficiaries are the residents of the residential homes who receive the broadcasts who total some 350 residents. Including the management committee we have over twenty volunteers. The move to Devizes School will allow us to work with the school providing a training facility for young people as well as a live broadcast studio and thus involve a bigger section of the community

The station raises its running costs by providing PA equipment for other charities at fetes, meetings and fund raising events, holding fundraising events such as quizzes, band concerts and finally through applications for small grants from Devizes Lions, Devizes Town Council and Devizes Rotary

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When we were notified that the lease on our present studio would not be renewed the management committee recognised that finding alternative premises would not be easy. Following a press campaign for accommodation we were approached by Devizes School who are looking to expand their media curriculum but do not have any expertise in radio broadcasting. Discussions identified that not only could the school be a source of volunteers for DHCR but that the radio station could play an important part in educating young people across a number of curriculum areas. This would include computer sciences, journalism, spoken English, written English, project planning and business studies. The benefits are that DHCR gains more volunteers which will increase the number of hours broadcasting which in turn will give our listeners a better experience and allow us to expand into other residential homes. At the same time the young people will be provided with an extra facility at the school which will enhance their education and help to provide a variety of learning experiences to help them when they start to look for full time work.
