An expression of interest has been received from Malmesbury Skate Park Group relating to the provision of a skate facility in Malmesbury.

Consultation evidence collected over the last decade from adults and young people alike have identified the need to provide a skateboard facility in Malmesbury. Following a number of investigations, the best option to provide this facility is behind the Youth Development Centre. To satisfy the needs of local people in respect to noise, the facility would be provided within a building.

The application to the Performance Reward Grant Scheme would be to provide such a building. This building would include toilets and some other facilities other than the skateboard (e.g. a climbing wall). The skateboard facility would be static and mobile to allow for a range of use for the building by young people from the Malmesbury Community Area. Funding for the skateboard equipment is already raised, following the long term aspiration for this facility for local young people
