This project is in respect of the provision of Speed Indication Devices (SID) in a number of villages.

There can be no doubt that a principle area of concern in many communities relates to vehicles speeding in villages, either in close proximity to schools or indeed areas where there are either pedestrians present or other road users. This can often be an actual problem but can also be a perceived issue.

The parishes of Bratton, Steeple Ashton, West Ashton and Keevil have been in discussion for a number of months regarding this issue and the central theme has been for these parishes to purchase a SID and move these around the villages. The effect of this would be to advise motorists of their speeds and look to alter driving habits through 'education' rather than the more often deployed approach of enforcement through the Camera Safety Partnership. In the case of Bratton and Steeple Ashton, they are subject to regular speed enforcement from the Camera Safety Partnership whereas as the remaining parishes are not.

In order to determine the extent of any problem, both West Ashton and Keevil were surveyed in the early summer of 2009. Both vehicles were found to have a speeding issue but the threshold did not warrant specific enforcement. Nevertheless, it did warrant the potential use of SIDs together with use at the other two parishes mentioned. Accordingly, the parishes have sufficient funds to look to cover 50% of the costs and are seeking a grant from the Area Board.

Wiltshire Council will be unable to meet the ongoing costs of your project. Please describe, therefore, how you will ensure the financial sustainability of your project beyond the period of this grant (if successful)?

The main part of this scheme is an initial capital outlay for which the funding is sought. There are consumables, in the form of batteries, and the parishes would look to provide finance to replace these outside of any warranty period.

3 – Additional information to support and strengthen your application e.g consultation, community involvement, energy efficiency measures

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As indicated, this application looks to reduce speeding in our villages through education. As a consequence, inhabitants in the villages will benefit through an anticipated reduction in the speed of traffic, which in turn reduces noise and pollution.

The project also demonstrates a strong partnership between the various parishes and with Wiltshire Council through the assistance being provided by the latter and the commitment from the former. This involves Wiltshire Council agreeing to move the devices around the villages and the parishes looking to fund 50% of the costs.

In terms of a success, an evaluation could be through examination of road traffic collision data and thankfully this remains low. We could also seek to gain the assistance of the Camera Safety Partnership to deploy their remote equipment to again survey the speed of vehicles and look to compare this with data held.
