ROAD CLOSURE – PART OF THE HIGH STREET WYLYE AND PART OF CHURCH STREET WYLE

- The council has a power to make an order closing roads for the period requested pursuant to Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847.
- The council has received an application from Mr Ivan Holliday, chairman of the Wylye Parish council and organiser of the annual Wylye village fete to be held on Saturday 3rd September 2005. He has requested permission to close the High Street between the Post Office and the Recreation Area between 10.00am and 5.00pm.
- Wiltshire County Council, as highway authority and Wiltshire Constabulary have been consulted
 and have confirmed there are no objections to the Closure. InterRoute, agents for the Highways
 Agency, state that the closure will not cause any problem to the A303, which passes nearby.
- 4. Mr Holiday confirmed that the residents of the Wylye were invited to attend a public meeting on 17th March 2005 at which the majority voted in favour of holding the fete in the High Street.
- It is not essential that the Order be published and is not intended to publicly advertise, but the Order will be confirmed to Wiltshire County Council and can appear on the Roadwatch website for road closures.
- The council's legal costs will be £150. Mr Holiday has agreed to meet these costs.
- It is proposed that the council should agree to make the Order pursuant to Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 subject to the council's legal costs being met.
