8. Amendment to SWAG grant for Salisbury and South Wiltshire Museum

On 26th January 2006 the Committee granted £450 to Salisbury and South Wiltshire Museum to run a puppet workshop for young people in Durrington and Amesbury. However, in October the lead for the project contacted the Council to inform officers that it was proving difficult to engage the services of the puppet group to deliver the project (see letter attached).

Therefore, the Museum has requested that the terms of the grant be varied to allow the alternative project to be delivered as outlined in the letter. If Members were minded to approve this variation then the project would be delivered between December 2006 and the end of February 2007 and the budget would remain the same. Since the attached letter was written, Ms Beasley has contacted Stonehenge School in Amesbury and the revised project would be targeting at least 130 –160 young people based at this school.
