Highways Act 1980 – Section 116
The Proposed Diversion of Bridleway no.29 Amesbury (part) and Byway Open to All Traffic no.1 Amesbury (part)


I am writing to advise you of an amendment to the application by the Amesbury Property Company, to divert Bridleway no.29 Amesbury (part) and Byway Open to All Traffic (BOAT), no.1 Amesbury (part). Wiltshire County Council are now proposing to make an application to the Magistrates Court, to include the following diversion proposals:

1. The diversion of BOAT no.1 Amesbury (part) to the west around scheduled ancient monument no.12200, as shown on the enclosed plan.
2. The diversion of Bridleway no.29 Amesbury (part), as shown on the enclosed plan.

We are therefore carrying out a new consultation as the proposed diversion route of Bridleway no.29, has been altered. I would like to serve notice of this new proposal upon Salisbury District Council and request the consent of the District Council for the making of an application to the Magistrates Court. I have enclosed the relevant consent form and would be very grateful if you could complete the form and return it to me at the address given above, before Tuesday 14th August. I would also be very grateful to receive any other comments which the District Council would like to make regarding the proposals. Please note that the District Council also has the power to veto the proposals if they should so wish and I would be very grateful if you could inform me if this is your decision.
