Response to drafting of condition 12 submitted by the applicant:

"I suggest that it is amended to a full draft report on the archaeological excavation of the proposed school site shall be submitted to the Local Planning Authority by December 2004. The original reason for this condition was that the excavation was undertaken before permission was granted and given the importance and consequential cost of reporting on those works it was considered appropriate to ensure that this was undertaken. The problem with the condition as it stands is that the finds from the Archer's grave have not been available for study for much of the time due to:

- (i) their being subject to the Inquest under the Treasure Act, or
- (ii) their being on there display in Salisbury, London or Cardiff (which was organised without regard to the need to prepare a report)".

WCC Archaeology - "I am happy with the proposals for a draft report by December 2004. This site has some unusual problems because of the spectacular nature of the finds and so this seems the best way forward".
