Heads of Terms of the S106 agreement are changed in accordance with the affordable housing provision, i.e.

(a) Affordable housing provision in accordance with Policy H2 of the West Wiltshire District Plan and the SPG on Affordable Housing subject to Housing Corporation funding of £70,000 per unit or 100% affordable housing provision;

Housing Enabling Officers advise that specifying the amount of £70 000 (whilst this figure had been raised during negotiations on this application), is too prescriptive given that there may need to be a departure from this amount in the current financial climate or where Housing Corporation criteria may change. It is therefore recommended that this part of the resolution should be amended to read:

(a) Affordable housing provision in accordance with Policy H2 of the West Wiltshire District Plan and the SPG on Affordable Housing or 100% affordable housing provision.

Cllr Clark requested that his vote in favour of an amendment – requesting 100% affordable housing provision in perpetuity be recorded, this vote was lost.

Cllr Clark requested that his vote of abstention against the substantive motion was recorded.
