**SALISBURY CITY CENTRE: RESIDENTS ONLY PARKING

SUPPLEMENTARY REPORT

Following the preparation of the main report a further 17 letters of objection have been received, after the official closing date. They are all from residents or businesses of Zone E and were sent following a public meeting held on 27th March organised by one of the residents.

The objectors are listed in **Appendix 1** to this report and the letters are available in the **Members' Room** at County Hall.

No new issues are raised but generally the objectors re-iterate the concern at the reduction in the number of spaces available for Zone E residents, the fact that they will have to pay £25 for a permit, and that the consultation process and decisions have been rushed through.

These points are covered in the considerations contained in the main report.
