**LYDIARD TREGOZE: PHASE II LANDFILL REDESIGN,
REVISED RESTORATION AND LANDSCAPING SCHEME
AND THE INSTALLATION OF A RECYCLING FACILITY -
STUDLEY GRANGE LANDFILL SITE, LYDIARD TREGOZE,
FOR BIFFA WASTE SERVICES LIMITED
(Application No. N.99.1696)**

**SUBMISSION OF DETAILS IN RELATION TO CONDITION 32
ATTACHED TO THE ABOVE APPLICATION REGARDING
THE NUMBER OF WASTE VEHICLES USING THE
STUDLEY GRANGE SITE ON AN ANNUAL BASIS**

1. At the 12th April 2000 meeting of the Environmental Services Sub-Committee, Members resolved to grant planning permission for the above development subject to 32 conditions.
2. Condition 32 required that:-

"Unless otherwise agreed in writing by the Waste Planning Authority, the average number of waste vehicles going to landfill over a twelve month period shall not exceed 45 vehicles per day. Details shall be provided to the Waste Planning Authority on an annual basis confirming the number of waste vehicles entering the landfill site, together with details of void space remaining, and that the position be reported annually."
3. In accordance with this requirement, Biffa Waste Services provided the required information which was considered by the Environmental Services Sub-Committee on 18th July 2001. The information provided at that time showed that the average waste vehicle numbers going to landfill site over a twelve-month period was 40 vehicles. With regard to the requirement of the condition, vehicles did not exceed the 45 vehicles per day allowed by the condition.
4. As Condition 32 stipulated that the position should be reported annually, Biffa have now provided figures for the period 28th April 2001 to 27th April 2002. These are as follows:-

Landfill loads during the period 28th April 2001 to 27th April 2002 = 10,613

Number of working days = 276

Average number of vehicles per day = $\frac{10,613}{276}$ = 38 vehicles

5. Vehicles have not exceeded the 45 per day allowed by the conditions and the average has actually reduced by two vehicles to 38 per day.
6. Concerning details of void space remaining, Biffa Waste Services Limited have confirmed that this stands at around 1.18 million m³.

Recommendation

7. That the Committee notes that the number of waste vehicles going to landfill at the Studley Grange Landfill Site over a twelve month period has not exceeded the 45 vehicles per day limit and that a further assessment be undertaken in twelve months time.
