MEMORANDUM AND WRITTEN STATEMENT (JANUARY 2001)**

Provision of Aggregates

MSP5 THE MINERAL PLANNING AUTHORITIES WILL SEEK TO:

1. MAINTAIN A LANDBANK FOR SAND AND GRAVEL IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE. IN DOING SO, SEPARATE LANDBANKS WILL BE MAINTAINED FOR SOFT SAND AND FOR SHARP SAND AND GRAVEL; AND
2. IDENTIFY PREFERRED AREAS, AREAS OF SEARCH AND SITE SELECTION CRITERIA FOR THE EXTRACTION OF SOFT SAND AND SHARP SAND AND GRAVEL IN THE MINERALS LOCAL PLAN BASED ON THE SUB-REGIONAL APPORTIONMENT AS AGREED BY THE REGIONAL AGGREGATES WORKING PARTY TO ENSURE THE MAINTENANCE OF THE LANDBANKS.

POLICY 34 AGGREGATE LANDBANKS

STOCKS OF PERMITTED RESERVES OF CRUSHED ROCK, SHARP SAND AND GRAVEL AND SOFT SAND (LANDBANKS) WILL BE MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT THE PLAN PERIOD IN ACCORDANCE WITH GOVERNMENT GUIDANCE WHEN DEVELOPMENT PROPOSALS ACCORD WITH ALL OTHER RELEVANT POLICIES OF THIS PLAN.

C6 WITHIN THE SPECIAL LANDSCAPE AREA, PROPOSALS FOR DEVELOPMENT IN THE COUNTRYSIDE WILL BE CONSIDERED HAVING PARTICULAR REGARD TO THE HIGH QUALITY OF THE LANDSCAPE. WHERE PROPOSALS WHICH WOULD NOT HAVE AN ADVERSE EFFECT ON THE QUALITY OF THE LANDSCAPE ARE ACCEPTABLE, THEY WILL BE SUBJECT TO THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:

- (i) THE SITING AND SCALE OF DEVELOPMENT TO BE SYMPATHETIC WITH THE LANDSCAPE; AND
- (ii) HIGH STANDARDS OF LANDSCAPING AND DESIGN, USING MATERIALS WHICH ARE APPROPRIATE TO THE LOCALITY AND REFLECT THE CHARACTER OF THE AREA.
