134. **Minutes of Previous Meeting**

- (ii) *In the light of the information obtained from the Highways Agency and Counsel, and having heard from officers of the stage reached in the highway works, the Committee considers that "completion", so as to satisfy Condition 6 of Planning Permission S.00.1519, should have been achieved by 30th October, 2002.*

- (iii) *That the final decision in respect of this matter be delegated to the Director of Environmental Services, following consultation with the Chairman and Vice-Chairman of the Committee.*
