

**MARLBOROUGH: FOOTPATHS 46 AND 47 -
OBJECTIONS TO MODIFICATION ORDER**

The Football Club objects for the following reasons:-

- (i) Health and safety caused by dog fouling or loitering
- (ii) Not all of the witnesses have 20 years use of the paths
- (iii) The Trustees never intended to dedicate rights of way
- (iv) Any fence erected across the path has been constantly broken down
- (v) Club officials have challenged walkers
- (vi) The path was not used until 1998

Mr. Edwards of Scarlett and Edwards Ltd. objects for the following reasons:-

- (i) The company fences off the land usually for several weeks every year
- (ii) The owner of 36 Barrow Close often has a builders skip and building material on the land over which the spur to Barrow Close crosses.

Mr. Doughty objects for the following reasons:-

- (i) Dogs foul the pitch
- (ii) The Football Club closed the path for a period of time but ceased this practice 10 years ago
- (iii) The Football Club has challenged people on the pitch

Mr. R. Norton, Director of Microlights, objects for the following reasons:-

- (i) The company does not concede that the footpath exists
- (ii) The access drive is used by vehicles servicing the company and this could be a safety concern
