Fankfunk will be aimed at young people but also adults who have an interest in music and media. We will be targeting the local community and aim to tackle social barriers such as drugs/alcohol anti social behaviour, equal opportunities and diversity. We have been engaging with young people for a number of years through other projects and we and the young people feel that there is a huge need for something new and dynamic to tackle issues that they face. We will be giving young people opportunities to take a look at themselves and their current situations and build confidence and raise self esteem. Young people who are socially excluded from other activities, schools or on probation orders are welcome to participate in the radio site. Building gaps and bridges for young people to look at taking careers in the music/media industry we hope to gain employment/events for them.

I won a Princes Trust award two years ago and brought the equipment back then to go towards equipment which was taken into youth centres for Dj workshops.

I have recently won an UN LTD award of £3000 which secured Fankfunk the equipment and costs that were needed to get us to this stage and also have a few hundred [£300] left for this stage we are trying to get further funding for. If we are successful in our application with you self we will be putting the remaining money £300 towards Fankfunks Internet radio station launch.

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We have set up a number of projects in the past and in communities in and around the surrounding areas. Projects such as Dj workshops, music/media projects and homeless football teams and competitions. I personally currently work with substance misuse individuals who are accessing an adults services and we roll out music groups which have some outstanding results in letting individuals express their emotions and feelings. So we aim to take Fankfunk to the internet, which is of course global, and help any one involved or listening to take some time out, get in touch with the music and themselves and spread some positive energy into the community. Later down the line and into the project we plan to hold events and even have guest appearances on the radio site. The main thing about Fankfunk is that at this stage anyone can join in and not just individuals who are based in a project. With the design and technology of Fankfunk individuals can get a personal log in account and play their set live from their own home. So we will be aiming at engaging in local community projects in and around Salisbury but also offer opportunities for the individuals who do not access such services, so reaching the harder to reach audience.
