FINAL DRAFT OF COMMUNITY PLAN FOR SOUTHERN AREA

Report Summary

To present the final draft of the community plan for the Southern area. The Area Committee is invited to make any final comments prior to the adoption of the plan by Cabinet and Council and to discuss how it can assist in taking forward the priorities identified in the plan.

1. Background

Salisbury District Council has a statutory duty to prepare a Community Strategy for the district, which will form part of its statutory Policy Framework. The previous generation of community plans have now reached the end of their life.

In June 2003, Cabinet agreed that six community plans would be developed at a community area level and that a district-wide community strategy would subsequently be developed. These will cover the period 2004-09. The community strategy will capture issues that are common to all areas and will contribute the South Wiltshire perspective to the county-wide community strategy.

2. Current Position

The community plans for 2005 - 2009 are currently in their final draft phase and are due to be formally adopted by the Board of the Alliance in November 2004. An early consultation draft of the Southern area plan was previously circulated for comments in April/May, but there have been substantial changes to the plan as a result of feedback.

There are six plans for South Wiltshire, one for each community area. Each plan summarises the main issues for the area which have been identified by consultation with local people. The plan also sets out what is being done to address these issues and what action will be taken over the next five years.

3. Recommendations

- (1) That the Area Committee make final amendments to the plan for Cabinet to consider on 24 November 2004;
- (2) That the Area Committee endorse the Southern area community plan and take an active part in its delivery;
- (3) That Community Champions meet with the interested local people to develop initiatives in the area supported by their Community Planner.
