**Landford First Responders**

Landford First Responders are a group of eight Volunteers who will attend medical emergencies in the rural area of Landford prior to the arrival of the Ambulance.

Before we can begin to offer this service effectively, the purchase of the basic medical equipment is necessary. The cost of this is £1500. Thereafter the costs of running this service will be covered by the Volunteers free time, The Great Western Ambulance Service and a small amount of fund raising for running expenses. Also donations from small businesses and funding from the Parish Council. The Parish Council have been approached but there are no funds available for this year.

The overall costs involved are as follows:-

Travelling expenses for volunteers for training Purposes. Training to be given on a regular basis e.g. every six months. Initially, training will be for two days. This will be undertaken at weekends in Volunteers free time.	£200
Volunteers time 365 day a year one volunteer on call at A time	£18,250 per year
Incidents per year depending on number of calls and distance travelled	£500 per year
