REPORT

COMPLAINT TO STANDARDS BOARD FOR ENGLAND

1. Purpose of Report :

To report to the Committee the outcome of a complaint to the Standards Board for England.

2. Background :

- 2.1 A complaint was received by the Standards Board for England alleging that Councillor Terry Daly of Alderbury Parish Council was abusive to the complainant in front of other Councillors and the general public and that he had been abusive in emails.
- 2.2 The Monitoring Officer has received notification from the Standards Board that it considered the complaint and decided not to refer it to an Ethical Standards Officer for investigation. This is because it was decided that the alleged conduct, although potentially disrespectful, is not of such significance of itself to justify investigation by an Ethical Standards Officer and any consequent action (even if it were found to have occurred).
