22. NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING TEAMS UPDATE

PC Nick Holt a community beat manager covering the Westbury area gave the Seminar the NPT update, points raised included:

- That Police are regularly patrolling Grassacres, Pc's now have keys to the public toilets and can now lock them if it is thought that they are being used by local youths etc to gather in.
- That Westbury's Neighbourhood Policing Teams will be targeting anti-social behaviour issues during the School holiday period.
- That there has been a spate diesel and fuel card thefts from business premises on the West Wilts Business Park.
- That 28% of crime is now being detected in the Westbury area, and that there has been a 20% reduction of reportable crime.
- That local youths have been advised by the NPT's to stay out of the Matravers School grounds.
- That a notice will be displayed at Westbury Police Station advising the public where lost property should be taken.
